The Winners' Circle Art Auction

Past award winners donate new works of art to be auctioned off. **A 50/50 split will benefit the annual WDC Best of Show artist awards fund and the contributing artist.** The auction precedes the live runway fashion show and is limited to 10 items featuring advance promotion.

Art Genres (each juried entry must select one category)

Accents

This category encompasses an eclectic grouping of functional art made from antler, ceramics, fiber, glass, leather, metal, or wood. All pieces are usable and would be recognized as art by just about any viewer.

Fashion

In this category, artists explore and expand the limits of their imagination and the style of the American West. You will find beautifully crafted pieces for "dressing West" from head-to-toe.

Jewelry

Western artists blend silver, gold, precious and semi-precious stones, turquoise, coral, antique china, and other materials to create one-of-a-kind jewelry and accessory pieces.

Leather

Leather has long been used in functional art, in pieces ranging from furniture to picture frames. This category displays hand tooling and leather manipulation of exquisite quality and craftsmanship.

Metal

From hand-pounded silver to hand-forged iron, this category encompasses heirloom-quality pieces of art that any collector or homeowner would be proud to display.

Mixed Media

Artists present functional works using a collaboration of materials. These creations incorporate multiple techniques, textures, and mediums. This category knows no limit and pushes the envelope of design and artistry.

Woodworking

This expansive category showcases timeless design, attention to detail, and traditional methods of craftsmanship. Each piece, whether simple or complex, will endure for generations.

The WDC is a gallery style exhibit... Booth spaces are limited, so apply early!

The attraction of the Exhibit + Sale is the high caliber and originality of the functional art on exhibit and available for purchase through out the show. Pedestals sit on the show floor individually or in front of booth space. Juried works are shown on white pedestals. Over \$20,000 is awarded annually to these entries.

A pedestal is REQUIRED to display your juried piece(s). A pedestal is of the utmost importance to maintain the visual integrity of a gallery (NO RUGS or DECORATIVE ITEMS MAY BE PLACED ON OR UNDER A PEDESTAL). A pedestal is designed to showcase and protect your work and is the responsibility of the artist.

PEDESTAL SPECIFICATIONS, CONSTRUCTION, FINISH & RENTALS

Pedestals are meant to showcase and protect your juried entry. **Each juried entry must be displayed on a square or rectangular white pedestal.** Each juried entry must be displayed on white pedestal. Only a single item, or ensemble is permitted. **Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own pedestal. Rentals are available.** The dimensions (HxWxD) are determined by the exhibitor.

Exhibit + Sale Booth Space

Juried artists can purchase booth space to show more of their work.

The conference is a gallery style exhibit; purchasing booth space allows artists the opportunity to create an intimate salesroom space for buyers and clients. Artwork displayed in booth space will not be part of the juried exhibition, and works sold there will not be eligible for awards or cash prizes. All artwork must be displayed inside the booth area. Booth spaces are limited, so apply early! See *Juried Artist Registration Form* for available sizes and rates.

Judging

Thursday, immediately following set-up.

YOU THE ARTIST have the opportunity to share your written story with the judges and the public; your knowledge and inspiration of materials used, design process, and concepts are important.

Describe your entry in 150 words or less. Include a typed description (in Times New Roman font) to allow the judges to gain your personal perspective as an artist when they review the piece presented.

We want you to have an equal opportunity to present your work to the judges. A judge's assistant will read each card aloud to the panel. List your company name, artist name, city and state below your description of the piece. **Place this card on your pedestal during set-up where it will remain for the duration of the 3-day WDC Exhibit + Sale.**

SHIPPING & DELIVERY

Items may be shipped to the venue prior to your arrival. Include: Your Name/WDC, Snow King Center, 100 E. Snow King Avenue, Jackson, WY 83001. Items may be shipped after the WDC with a pre-paid UPS/FEDEX label. NOTHING IS TO BE LEFT BEHIND AT THE SHOW.

BADGES & SECURITY

Exhibitor badges are mandatory for entry into the show. Exhibitor badges must be worn at ALL times. This is to provide maximum security for all artists - NO EXCEPTIONS. Badges will be included in your welcome packet at check-in.

TICKETS

Each artist/exhibitor receives 10 complimentary day passes for guests (\$30 each /\$300 total value). These Exhibit + Sale tickets will be held under the artist's name at the Ticket Window for guests to pick up courtesy of the WDC. Remember to invite your clients!! Each artist/exhibitor receives 3 complimentary Preview Party + Fashion Show General Admission tickets in their welcome packet (\$75 each/\$225 total value). *A ticket is required for all artists/exhibitors to attend. Additional tickets to all events are sold online in advance and at the door.*

FOUR LEGGED FRIENDS Due to new venue regulations dogs are no longer permitted.

PAYMENT & REGISTRATION

Booth space, pedestal floor space and Designer Show House rooms are limited and on a first come, first serve basis, reserve early. A minimum 25% deposit is due to hold any space. Registration is online via your acceptance email.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation before June 1 will be subject to an administrative fee of \$100.
Cancellation after June 1 will be subject to 50% of the confirmed booth and pedestal fee.
NO REFUNDS after July 1, 2022.

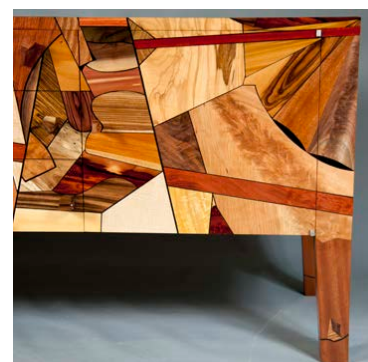
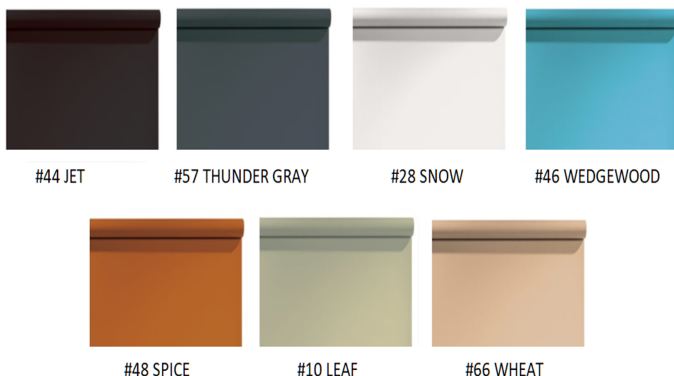
